## **Phase 2 Church Reopening**

According to the Directives of the Greek Orthodox Metropolis of Detroit for the Reopening of Churches, on Sunday, June 28<sup>th</sup>, we enter Phase 2 of the Church reopening process. All measures imposed in Phase 1 will still be in place (mandatory wearing of masks, social distancing, and no agape/coffee hour), but we will be allowed to use 100% of the church area.

Starting this Sunday, those of you who want to participate in the services in person in church will not be required to sign up anymore. However, because we still must follow social distancing rules, please follow the following rules when you come to church:

- please enter the church premises using Entrance 2
- please bring a mask or face covering for yourself (or you will be offered a mask as you enter the church premises for a \$1 donation)
- please maintain social distancing while waiting in line to buy and light candles
- please follow the directives of the greeters for being placed in a pew. In order to follow the social distancing rules, every other pew will be blocked.
- the pews will be filled on a first come first serve basis. When/if the available pews in the nave of the church will be filled, worshipers will be placed in the choir loft. When/if the choir loft will be filled, worshipers will be placed in the social hall where the services will be livestreamed on a big screen TV.
